Have you ever thanked God your big toe?

We don't often think about our big toes unless we stub them or drop something on them. When that happens, they're pretty much all we can think of! Well, it turns out that big toes are extremely important when it comes to jumping. In fact, you can't jump without big them!

In Judges, we read the story of Adoni-Bezek, a conquered king whose thumbs and big toes the Israelites cut off. In his only recorded words in the Bible, the former king



confesses that he, himself, had cut off the thumbs and big toes of 70 kings whom he had defeated. I used to think that this was done as an act of humiliation, and, I'm sure, on some level, it was. However, it was also a way of incapacitating an enemy. (As an experiment, try to open a wide-mouthed pickle jar or to sign your name without using your thumbs. Yes, it's possible, but it's definitely not easy!)

For a variety of reasons people sometimes think that they're insignificant — just a toe or a thumb in the body of Christ. Sometimes, it's because of ("I'm too old," or "I'm just a kid"), or maybe

because of health or financial challenges or what they do for a living. The Bible, however, reminds us over and over that God delights in using those whom the world discounts and overlooks. You are precious to him!

Take a look at the envelope that this letter came in. If your name is on it, I thank God for you regularly! (I really mean that!)

Never underestimate anyone's value – including your own – because that person seems small and insignificant. Remember, it's not our ability that determines how much we can achieve but how willingness we are to be used by God.
