Do you remember learning how to walk? If your experience was like mine, it was a very frustrating, embarrassing and difficult time. I was trying to learn how to use muscles that weren't fully developed, to get them to do things that I'd never tried before, and trying to figure out how to balance my body and move forward in ways that were new to me. Unfortunately, I didn't have the



opportunity to figure it out in private, by myself. Instead, I was surrounded by people who, instead of helping me, stood just beyond my reach, taunting me to come to them. When I fell (and I fell a lot, hurting my knees or my backside), rather than helping me, they pointed at me and laughed or said, "Aww," as though it weren't the most traumatic experience of my young life.

Looking back on it, I'm glad that I know how to walk, but, honestly, if I had to do it all over again, I'd probably stick to crawling.

That's ridiculous, isn't it? The truth is that I don't even remember learning how to walk, although I'm sure it was a big deal for me at the time. And can you imagine how ridiculous I'd look, as a 60-year-old man, crawling everywhere?

Paul wrote to the Roman church that, "our present sufferings are not worth comparing with the glory that will be revealed in us." (Romans 8:18) I would never minimize the very real struggles and pain that many of you are, no doubt, going through right now. No, I'm just here to encourage you that the struggles are not in vain! There will come a time when the glorious future that God is developing in us will come to fruition, and these times of trial will fade away from memory. "When we've been there ten thousand years, bright shining as the sun," we'll no longer remember the pain and frustration, but we will live through countless ages of eternity in the plane of glory that the suffering equipped us for. Stay strong!

Therefore we do not lose heart. Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day. For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all. So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal.
