This was not a recent killing field. These were bones of men who had been dead for a long time. All the flesh and sinew was gone from their bones, and the bones themselves had dried.

Imagine the look of wonder and surprise on Ezekiel's face as he saw bone joining with bone, and then muscle, sinew and flesh appearing. Ezekiel was no stranger to the sight of God's miracles, but he had certainly never seen anything like the reconstruction of this vast army.

And yet, they were still dead.

As unimaginable as this miracle was, it would have been nothing more than a parlor trick if it had ended there. However, God doesn't do miracles just as a show of power or for the sake of novelty. Miracles are God's power with a purpose.

God began this miracle with the question, "Can these bones live?" – a question that was answered only when Ezekiel, at God's command, prophesied to the wind, and the breath of God entered the bodies.

In 2005, Highway's pastor and deacons accepted the challenge of reviving a historic church at 17th and Tioga Streets, in North Philadelphia's Nicetown neighborhood. Long in disrepair, the building had abandoned and looted, and it lay desolate – but it had, in the parlance of the building restoration trade, good bones!

I remember the Saturday morning when the restoration kicked off in earnest. Representatives from throughout the vast PennDel district came to work, as did teams of students from our A/G colleges, interns and other volunteers. Their efforts, and the efforts of many other teams that came and pitched in over the three-year restoration period, were invaluable. However, there were many more Saturdays when the work was carried out only by our pastor, alone in the building and faithful to the call that he had accepted. I have to wonder whether he ever looked around him and asked God the same question that God had asked Ezekiel, "Can these bones
