To me, fishing means putting bait on a hook, casting it out into the water and luring a fish onto the line. I think this is what a lot of Christians have in mind when they think of Jesus' declaration to his future disciples – that he would send them out to fish for people. So many churches' approach to evangelism is finding something that will attract the lost, tossing it in front of them and reeling them in. This, though, was not the way that those future disciples fished. For them, fishing wasn't a sport or a leisure activity; it was their livelihood. Their technique was throwing out a large net and snatching loads of fish from the water.

Jesus met Peter after Peter and his partners had fished all through the night without



catching anything. At Jesus' command, they put out into deep water and threw out their nets again - this time catching so many fish that their two boats almost sank!

By giving them this miraculous catch of fish, Jesus was also giving them (and us!) the secret to fishing for people. Success doesn't come from having the right bait or

the best equipment, but, rather, from obeying God through faith and throwing the nets out when and where he directs. He might direct you to invite that neighbor whom you've known for 30 years to church on Sunday. He might direct you to talk to the stranger waiting in front of you at the checkout line. His direction might not seem to make sense, but, if you trust and obey, you'll catch many fish.

There are many, many fish in our North Philadelphia neighborhood, but the fishing here is hard. Resurrection Life Church perseveres for one simple reason: It's where God directed us to cast our nets. We won't give up – and we're counting on our prayer partners not to give up – until our nets reach the breaking point!

"Master, we've worked hard all night and haven't caught anything. But because you say so, I will let down the nets." When they had done so, they caught such a large number of fish that their nets began to break. (*Luke 5:5,6*)
