

Sunday mornings at Resurrection Life Church begin with "Breakfast with Jesus" – a church-family gathering with people of all ages and every level of Christian experience joining together for a continental breakfast and some time in the Bible. We're currently going through *The Story*, the Bible's history books arranged in chronological order.

I was privileged to have grown up in a home that featured nightly devotionals, where each of us — parents and children — took turns reading the Bible out loud and praying together. My mother used to say that our family wasn't rich, but we were Bible-rich — and we truly were! Sadly, even within the church, many families don't have this biblical underpinning.



I've served on church leadership teeams and boards for more than three decades where we've agonized over how to address the issue of spiritual illiteracy. I wish I had the solution (and the money!) to solve this problem, but I believe that we, at RLC, are taking an important first step by exposing our church family to the stories of the

Bible. Yes, there's much more that they will need to learn – about the prophecy, the letters and the poetry in the Bible – and we'll address those in due time, but what better way to introduce people to the character and nature of our great and loving God than to share the stories of his interaction with his creation? I believe that to be the essence of our mission as Christians: to share the wonderful works of God with the next generation.

Let's take a quick health check: How are you doing with your Bible reading? I would encourage you to give God's Word its due in your daily life. Give time to Bible study, yes, but also take the time to listen to the Scriptures. Why not take a break from your favorite podcast or talk show or music playlist — whatever is playing in the background as you sit in the car, around the house or at work, and just listen Word of God for thirty minutes? There are many great audio options available. Feel free to reach out to me for some suggestions, both internet-based and off-line.

We are shaped by what we give our time to. Let's be shaped by the Word of God!
