During the first service that I ever attended at Highway Tabernacle, in the spring of 1989, Florence Bogdan, standing behind the pulpit to give the announcements, pointed to her right towards some text and a logo painted in gold on the wall. She explained that the paint work was the final piece of restoration from the fire. I learned later that the church building had been devastated by fire three years earlier and that the text and the logo had featured in every building that Highway had occupied in its then-92 years.

In the first recorded minutes of what later became Highway Mission
Tabernacle, it's written that, on
Thanksgiving day, November 29, 1894,
"some eight or nine surviving members of the disbanded Cross and Crown" met during an all-day prayer meeting, seeking a further move of God in Philadelphia.
(In those days, Thanksgiving was celebrated on the last Thursday of November, rather than the fourth Thursday.)

Church Delaware to Perma Thanksgiving day Thursday Movember 29th 1894 at an all day meeting which some Eight or Nine attended at the kind invitation of the Payfor Rev Chas Langley, at about two Oclock in the afternoon it was suggested me reorganize our asstrated after all who were freeent expressed their opinions and suggested plans of work. Oro Chas Langly was blocked chairman for the afternoon and J. R. Alhundhefre Theretery. On motion of Oro Frederick Reel which was duly seconded and carried we were again organized with a working body the same to be called the bross and brown association. On motion of Oro. Win Reel

In the thirty-four years that I have been associated with Highway, we have employed several mottos: "Over 100 years of continuous city ministry," "Building a family to serve a community," "Following God, Loving People, Sharing Hope," and, currently, "Reach, Teach, Mend, Send." Through it all, though, we've remained true to the principle of our logo, bearing the *cross* that we may wear the *crown*.

This Thanksgiving marks 129 years of God's faithfulness to Philadelphia through Highway MissionTabernacle! Thank you for your faithfulness in standing with us!
