Every night when I was growing up, our family met in the family room for devotions at 7:30. We each took turns reading out loud from the Bible – my father, in his steady baritone, reading from the Revised Standard Version, and the rest of us reading, at various times, from the King James Version, the Living Bible or the Amplified Bible.

If you've had me as a Sunday School teacher, you've probably heard me rhapsodize about my father's wisdom. There were two things in particular that strike me as wise in the way he conducted our family's devotions.

First, our devotions were held at a specific time. My father let us children choose the time, and we picked 7:30 because there was nothing good on TV then. While that wasn't the most spiritual reason, it helped lessen our distractions, keeping us from rushing through the time lest we miss our favorite program. Beyond that, though, there was wisdom in setting a specific time for devotions. When there's no set appointment, it's easy for things to



slip off the radar or to be out-prioritized, especially when there are several people's schedules to coordinate. In our family, we knew not to plan for anything at 7:30, because that time was earmarked for devotions.

The second wise thing was having each of us read the Bible out loud. It's a lot easier to gloss over a passage when you're just listening to it, or even when you're reading it silently to yourself. We engage with a text differently when we actually pronounce its words out loud. Reading out loud calls for more contemplation; — rather than gobbling down whole sentences and paragraphs, we must digest the text word by word, giving the Word its due.

At the turn of the year, I like to encourage people to embark on a Bible-reading journey. While I wholeheartedly recommend reading the Bible through in a year, I know that this can be an intimidating task. You shouldn't stress over it. Bible reading should not be a chore. Just commit to reading one chapter every day and stick with it! You might miss a day here or there, but come back to it. You'll thank me later.

Blessed is the one who reads aloud the words of this prophecy, and blessed are those who hear it and take to heart what is written in it. (Revelation 1:3)
