"Brothers and sisters, pray for us." I Thessalonians 5:25



After she told Jesus that the wine had run out at the wedding, his mother, Mary, told the servants to do whatever he told them - giving us the key to experiencing miracles.

If we expect to see God do miracles, we must be prepared to do whatever he tells us. There are three things, in particular, that we must be willing to do.

First, we must be willing to let go of the things that are not like him. For the rich young ruler who sought the miracle of eternal life, this meant letting go of material things. Like him, we may be called to let go of greed, but perhaps our call will be to let go of the pride that makes us hold grudges, the anger that poisons our relationships, or the envy or lust that corrupts our thoughts. Whatever we are holding onto, we can't move forward with Jesus – and we can't expect miracles – until we let go.

Second, we must be willing to take a step of faith, like the ten lepers whom Jesus told to show themselves to the priests and who were healed on the way. To be clear: Faith is not presumption. We cannot declare miracles and begin walking in them when Jesus has not directed us. However, once he tells us what to do, we must move boldly in faith, confident that we have received what he promised.

Finally, we must be persistent, as Jesus taught in the parable of the corrupt judge. Although the judge neither feared God or cared about people, Jesus said that he gave the widow justice because she kept pestering him. How much more will God, who *does* care about people, bring about justice if we persist in asking?

There is one more key, and it's the most important. Jesus told his apostles that they had to remain in him, the Vine, if they were to bear fruit. With that as the context, he added that, if they remained in him and his Word remained in them, they could ask for whatever they wanted, and it would be done. The final key is that, to claim the promise of asking whatever we want, we must abide in him, bear his fruit, and allow him to shape our will and our requests. Remain in him. Let him guide your steps. Then, whatever miracles he puts on your heart, ask him for!

The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective. (James 5:16)
